WE HAVE YOU COVERED

Working with our partners, successful candidates accepted to the programme are covered for:

- **Return travel expenses** to the country of the host institution
- **Accommodation** for the duration of the visit (normally 4 to 6 weeks)
- **Living expenses** (food and beverage) during the visit
- **Health insurance** costs during the stay.
