

# Report on the Activities of the WFN Research Group ALS/MND 2015

Chair: Prof. Dr. A. C. Ludolph

We achieved the following goals and performed the following activities:

1. We continued the close collaboration of the WFN Research Group for ALS/MND (Prof. Dr. Albert C. Ludolph) and the WFN Research Group for Aphasia and Cognitive Disorders (Prof. Dr. Thomas Bak, Prof. Dr. Facundo Manes)

The following activities were done collaboratively:

- a. Organization of educational programs worldwide (including activities in Ecuador, the EAN/Berlin and on the WFN meeting in Santiago de Chile)
- b. A screening test for frontotemporal deficits in ALS has been translated into Chinese and Mongolian language. The first papers are being published. (Abrahams S, Newton J, Niven E, Foley J, Bak TH. Screening for cognition and behaviour changes in ALS. Amyotroph Lateral Scler Frontotemporal Degener. 2014;15:9-14).
- c. The first meeting of the collaborative group for ALS and FTD at the European Academy of Neurology took place in Berlin 2015. A collaborative educational program was performed in Quito (Ecuador) in January 2015.
- d. The NiSALS-Group (Neuroimaging Society in ALS/FTD has successfully completed a number of papers which communicates the methodology of data acquisition in ALS (Kassubek).

#### 2. Revision of the El Escorial Criteria

The process to revise the El Escorial Criteria has been finished. The paper appeared in the Journal Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis and Frontotemporal Degeneration (Ludolph A, Drory V, Hardiman O, Nakano I, Ravits J, Robberecht W, Shefner J; WFN Research Group On ALS/MND.
