

**Joint Meeting of Central Eastern European Stroke Society and the WFN Research Group on Organization and Delivery of Neurological Services (RG ODNs)**

42<sup>nd</sup> Danube Symposium for Neurological Sciences and Continuing Education  
Zagreb, Croatia  
21 – 23 October, 2010

The 42<sup>nd</sup> Danube Symposium for Neurological Sciences and Continuing Education with a full-day Cochrane-European Association of Young Neurologist and Trainees (EAYNT) Workshop in Evidence-Based Neurology was held in Zagreb, Croatia from October 21-23, 2010. This was a joint venture of 4 important scientific meetings including the 5<sup>th</sup> Congress of the Croatian Society for Neurovascular Disorders of the Croatian Medical Association and the Croatian Stroke Society, 10<sup>th</sup> Congress of the European Society for Clinical Neuropharmacology and Joint meeting of Central Eastern European Stroke Society (CEESS) and the World federation of Neurology (WFN) Research Group on Organization and Delivery of Neurological Services (RG ODNs).

Joint meeting of CEESS, WFN RG ODNs and Croatian Stroke Society was organized on Friday, October 22, 2010. The main theme of the meeting was *Stroke Management*. The meeting started with Professor A. Czlonkowska (Poland) who talked about *Thrombolysis in the Region*. Lj. Bumbaširević (Serbia) gave an interesting presentation about *Stroke Unit as Secondary Prevention Center*. In her lecture, Professor V. Demarin (Croatia) gave an outstanding overview of *Carotid Disease*. Further on, B. Žvan (Slovenia) presented *Management of Subarachnoidal Hemorrhage*, followed by the lecture of O. Sinanović (Bosnia and Herzegovina) who talked about *Post-Stroke Aphasia*. In his excellent presentation, L. Csiba (Hungary) presented *Interventions in Acute Ischemic Stroke*. The meeting finished with the closing remarks of the Professor L. Battistin (Italy) who concluded the gathering with the successful ending. Local Organizing Committee, guided by Professor V. Demarin tried to do their best to meet broad interests and needs of the participants and speakers. The overall impression of the Zagreb 2010 Symposium and Joint meeting of CEESS, WFN RG ODNs and Croatian Stroke Society mentioned by the participants was outstanding and valuable experience.
