The main focus of this course covers issues and challenges at the so-called boundaries of neurology and psychiatry. In fact, the theoretical and clinical implications of neuropsychiatric disorders invite us to more comprehensive and integrative approaches. Besides, for a better management of neuropsychiatric disorders the collaboration between neurologists and psychiatrists needs to be improved. The content and organization of this course is exemplary of such collaborative work. In this course, descriptive, explanatory, treatment and management issues of some most prevalent disorders as ADHD, Depression and Anxiety will be reviewed and the highlights of genetics in psychiatric disorders will be discussed.
