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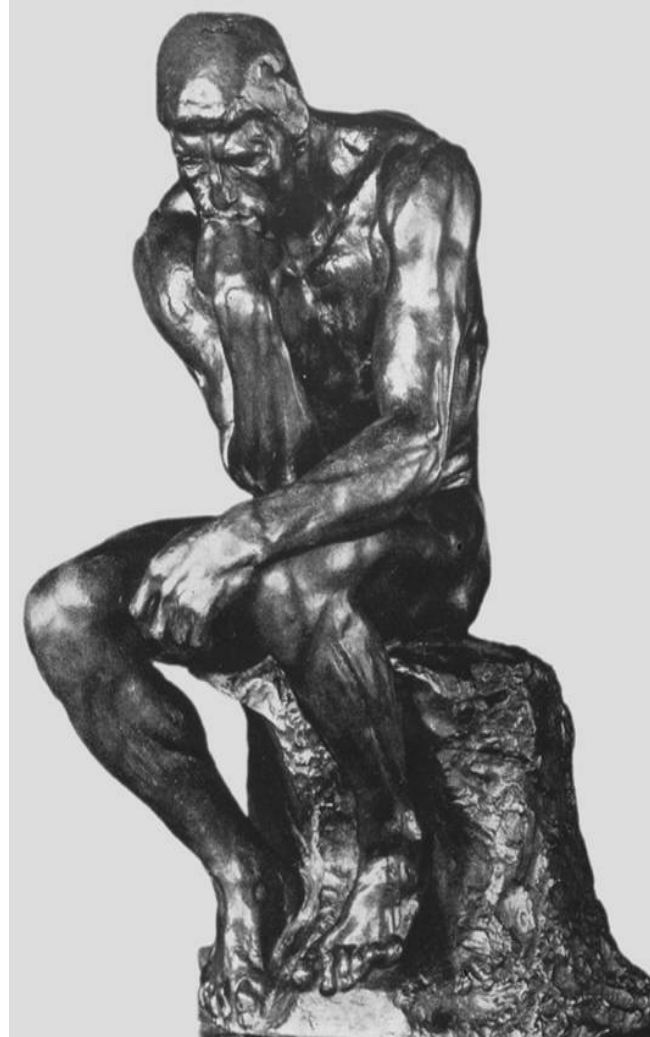
Neuropalliation is a term that emphasizes the firm link between an expertise in palliative care and one in neurology.

Throughout her life, Dame Cicely Saunders had conceded that patients with neurologic and neurodegenerative diseases had a difference from oncology patients when it came to end-of-life care.

Main Challenges for Neuropalliative Care in Europe

- Not many neurologists have palliative care education
- Too less patients with neurological symptoms are included in palliative care services
- Diagnose Dying in neurological units in Germany
- Palliative care units only rarely take care for neurological patients
- Hospices restrict numbers of neurological patients
- To less education and workshops

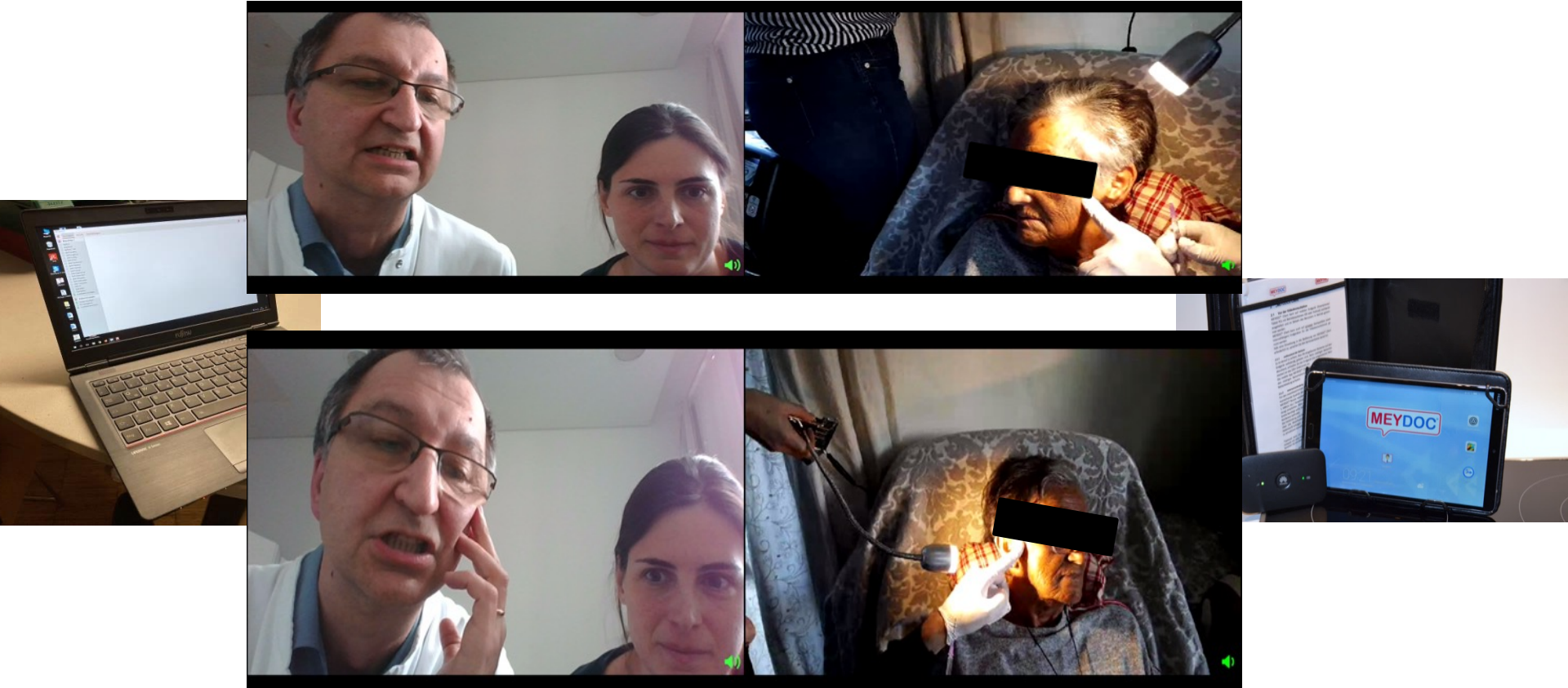

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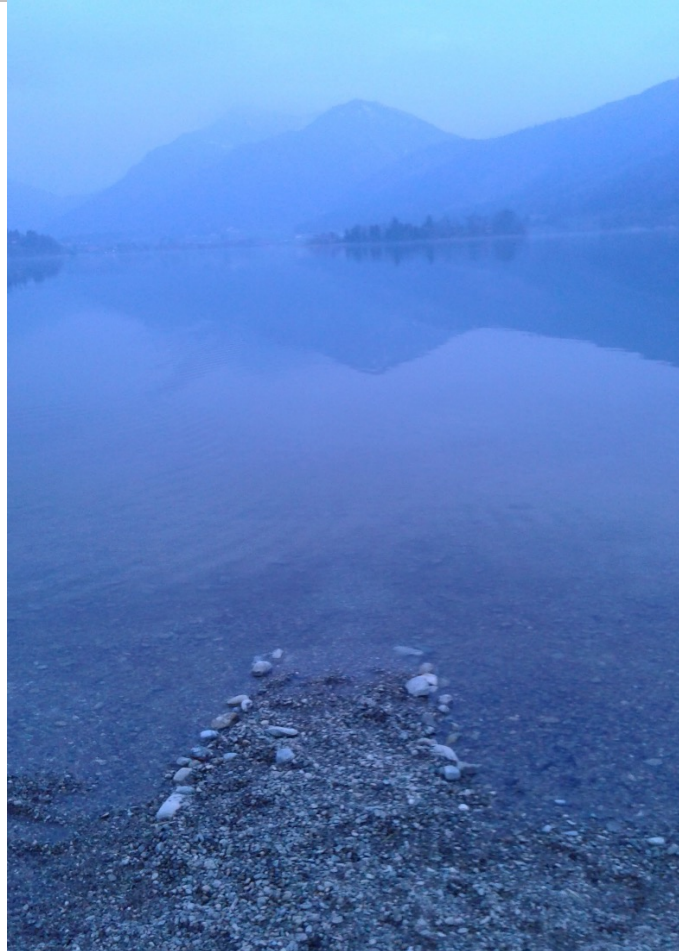
